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SECTION II: SPECIAL REMARKS

TREATMENT OF FRINGE BENEFITS:

The fringe benefits are charged using the rate(s) listed in the Fringe Benefits Section of this Agreement. The fringe benefits included in the rate(s) are listed below.

TREATMENT OF PAID ABSENCES

Vacation, holiday, sick leave pay and other paid absences are included in selaries and wages and are claimed on grants, contracts and other agreements as part of the normal cost for selaries and wages. Separate claims are not made for the cost of these paid absences. Unused leave payments made upon separation are included in the fringe benefit rates.

OFF-CAMPUS DEFINITION: For all activities performed in facilities not owned by the institution and to which rent is directly allocated to the project(s) the off-campus rate will apply. Grants or contracts will not be subject to more than one F&A cost rate. If more than 50% of a project is performed off-campus, the off-campus rate will apply to the entire project.

Fringe benefits include FICA/Medicare, retirement, disability insurance, life insurance, TIAA/CREF, unemployment insurance, dental and health insurance, worker's compensation, separation leave payments, tuition remission, employee assistance, and wellness programs.

Equipment means an article of nonexpendable tangible personal property having a useful life of more than one year and an acquisition cost of \$5,000 or more per unit.

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SECTION III: GENERAL

A. DIMITATIONS.

The rates in this agreement are subject to any statutory or administrative limitations and apply to a given grant, contract or other agreement only to the extent that funds are available. Acceptance of the rates is subject to the following conditions: (1) Only costs incurred by the organization were included in its facilities and administrative dost pools as finally accepted; such costs are legal obligations of the organization and are allowable under the governing cost principles; (2) The serve costs that have been treated as facilities and administrative costs are not claimed as direct costs; (3) Similar types of costs have been treated as facilities and administrative costs are not claimed as direct costs; (3) Similar types of costs have been eccarded consistent accounting treatment; and (4) The information provided by the organization which was used to establish the rates is not later found to be materially incomplete or inacourate by the Federal Covernment. In such situations the rate(s) would be subject to renegotiation at the discretion of the Federal Government.

B. ACCOUNTING CHANGERS

This Agreement is based on the accounting system purported by the organization to be in effect during the Agreement period. Changes to the method of accounting for costs which affect the amount of reimbursement resulting from the use of this Agreement require prior approval of the authorized representative of the cognizant agency. Such changes include, but are not limited to, changes in the charging of a particular type of cost from facilities and administrative to direct. Failure to obtain approval may result in cost disallowances.

If a fixed rate is in this agreement, it is based on an estimate of the costs for the period covered by the rate. When the actual costs for this period are determined, an adjustment will be sade to a rate of a future year(s) to companiest for the difference between the costs used to establish the fixed rate and actual costs.

USS BY OTHER FEDERAL ACENCIES:

The rates in this Agraement were approved in accordance with the authority in Office of Hanagement and Budget Circular A. 21, and should be applied to grante, contracts and other agraements covered by this Circular, subject to any limitations in A above. The organization may provide copies of the Agraement to other Paderal Agencies to give them early notification of the Agreement.

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If any Federal contract, grant or other agreement is relaborating facilities and administrative costs by a means other than the approved rate(s) in this Agreement, the organization should (1) credit such costs to the affected programs, and (2) apply the approved rate(s) to the appropriate base to identify the proper amount of facilities and administrative costs allocable to these programs.
